If EITCI permits such a cure period, EITCI Accredited Certification Licensee's failure to cure any default within the cure period shall automatically cause the termination of this Agreement without further notice.

6.5. Effect of termination

Upon the termination of this Agreement, the Certification Licensee shall immediately cease to represent himself as EITCI Accredited Certification Licensee.

7. Limitation and liability
In no event shall EITCI be liable for any indirect, special, incidental, consequential damages, including lost profits, of any kind regardless of the form of action, whether in contract, tort (including negligence), strict liability, or otherwise, even if EITCI has been advised of the possibility of such damages. This limitation will apply notwithstanding any failure of essential purpose of any limited remedy provided herein. EITCI Accredited Certification Licensee may not assign any rights, licenses or obligations received under this Agreement to anyone. Any attempted assignment in violation of this Agreement shall be null and void and without effect.

8.1. Waiver and modification
EITCI Certified Training Programme Provider waives any right to challenge the validity and enforceability of this Agreement on the grounds that it was transmitted and entered into electronically.
